It delivers overall identity and access governance functionality seamlessly integrated with automated provisioning. Features include life-cycle management for users and roles, cross-platform and rule-based provisioning in real-time, Web-based user self-service and delegated administration, request workflows, access certification, password management, metadirectory and auditing and reporting.

This course provides training for DirX Identity administration. It includes the features and architecture of the product DirX Identity and teaches how to setup, configure, administer and monitor the product. The course is well balanced between theoretical concepts and practical exercises.
